Oral exams in telematic modality

INSTRUCTION FOR THE STUDENTS

- 1. As usual on your myUnito you will find the calendar of appeals to which you are enrolled/ with the new date of April
- 2. At the online exam session the other students/students/students enrolled/and the same appeal can be connected by videoconference.
- 3. During the examination, you will not be able to use materials (e.g. texts, etc.) not authorised by the Examination Board, nor the help of third parties, otherwise the examination will be invalidated as usual.
- 4. You will receive an email from the teacher with the address to connect to on the day of the exam. We advise you to do some tests in the previous days.
- 5. On the day of appeal, connect to the address you received by email at the appointed time and make sure you have a valid identification document with you.
- 6. Keep your inbox open during the exam session to receive any communication from the teacher (e.g. problems in the videoconferencing connection).
- 7. The President of the Commission will proceed to your recognition.
- 8. The other students will be able to listen with the microphone disabled.
- 9. At the end of the examination, the President will inform you of the outcome and the grade and with your consent will record it in the usual way.
- 10. The instructions for using the service are available in MyUnito by consulting the <u>Webex</u> pages, after authentication with the credentials of the University.

CANDIDATES WITH DISABILITIES OR SPECIFIC LEARNING DISABILITIES (DSA)

If you hold a certificate of disability pursuant to Law 104/92 and all subsequent modification. or a certificate of invalidity with a percentage equal to or greater than 50% or hold certification of Specific Learning Disorders (DSA) pursuant to Law 170/2010, may require an adaptation of the assessment test, in accordance with current regulations and according to specific certified difficulties, while maintaining the learning objectives. Such adaptation must be required through the usual procedure of filling in and sending by mail to the teacher of the "individualized treatment request form for examinations" available in the web pages of UNITO dedicated to students with disabilities/DSA to this <u>link</u>.
